## **GRANTS COMMITTEE INVITES YOUR INPUT**

Giving money away sounds so simple... in reality, it's a well-thought-out, sophisticated process. Each August and September, the Grants Committee extensively reviews local area grant requests. Face-to-face presentations, interviews and research of past donation effectiveness are incorporated into their evaluation. Proposals are judged on their clarity, feasibility, importance, need and humanitarian outreach in the community.

The Committee is currently accepting requests from Highlands-Cashiers area 501(c)3 not-for-profit organizations. Eligible organizations can expect to receive amounts ranging from \$1000 to \$5000 after our seasonal fundraising.

If you know of an organization that would like to request a grant application from CWO, please contact: Brenda Manning or Karen Leabo. The CWO does not fund religious, political or capital campaigns. The deadline for applications is August 2, 2010.

If you are interested in serving on the Grants Committee, contact Brenda or Karen for more information. Their first meeting will be held on Monday, July 19th at 11:30am. Committee members must attend 80 percent of the review meetings to ensure adequate preparation to make the best possible grant decisions.
